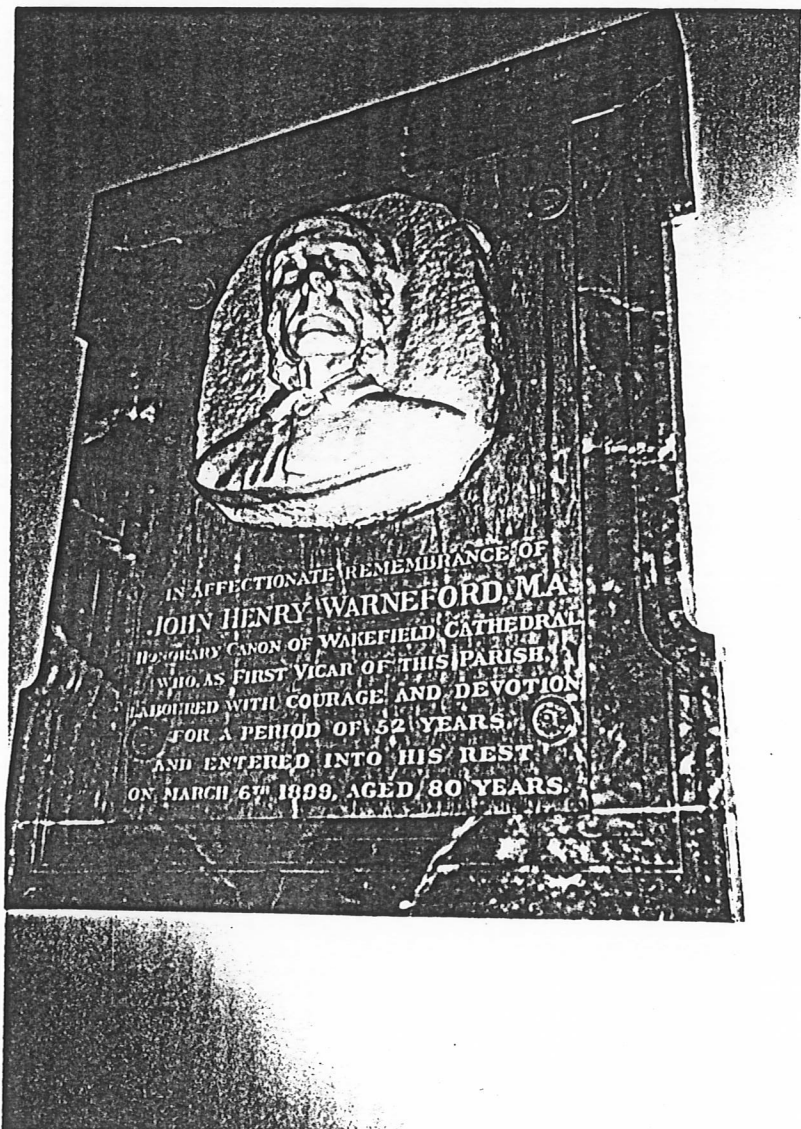

To The Glory of God and in loving memory of/Walter Kemeys Francis  
Goodall/WARNEFORD, A.F.C.,/Captain in the Royal Air Force,/who  
joined the Royal Air Service in 1914,/served with the forces in  
France,/and later was in command of H.M. Airship N.S.11./This  
gallant pilot served in the European War/1914 to 1918, was  
mentioned twice in despatches,/and received the thanks of the Air  
Council for zeal and devotion to duty,/and was awarded the Air  
Force Cross./Whilst on mine clearance operations off/Sheringham,  
July 15th 1919, N.S.11. exploded during a thunder-storm, with the  
total/loss of her crew./He was the only child of /Walter Wyndham  
Hanbury WARNEFORD, O.B.E.,/and Mary Elizabeth, his wife,/of  
Huyton, Liverpool,/and was baptized in this[sic] church./He was  
Grandson of Canon J.H. WARNEFORD/of Warneford Place, Highworth,  
Wilts.,/who was first vicar of this parish./This tablet is  
erected by his parents/to their brave and fearless son./aged  
24./"The Lord is thy keeper." Psalm CXXi./CULN Gawthorpe & Sons  
London./
