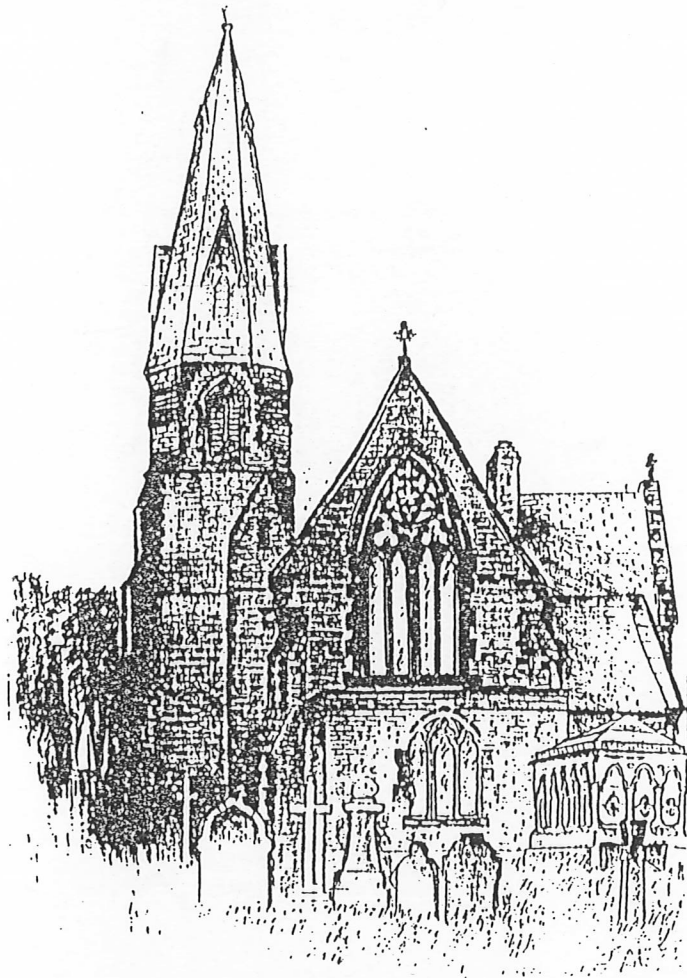



HALIFAX ALL SAINTS', SALTERHEBBLE PARISH.

DUDWELL, HALIFAX

1846 - 1987

All Saints' parish came into being in 1846 following the passing of Sir Robert Peel's New Parishes Act 1843. This act made possible the carving up of very large parishes and the creation and endowment of new parishes in growing industrial areas.

Under the act Halifax parish was assigned five new districts of which Salterhebble was one. The district was delineated in the "London Gazette" as follows;

"All that part of the said township of Skircoat situate on the eastern and southern sides of the said district of King Cross: and such parts of the township of Southowram in the said parish of Halifax as is situate on the western side of an imaginary line commencing at a point on the boundary between the said township of Skircoat where such a boundary is crossed by Siddal Lane, and at or near to Paris-gates and thence extending southwards along the middle of such lane, Pit Lane and Park Lane to a point opposite to the North East corner of a certain farm house and premises called "Park Gate" and thence along the eastern wall of such house and premises to the boundary between the said township of Southowram and the township of Elland in the said parish of Halifax."

Thus the original ecclesiastical district comprised what are now the parishes of All Saints', Saint Judes', Saint Marks, Siddal and Copley. It had a population of 2,200.

In 1846 Archdeacon Dr Charles Musgrave, Archdeacon of Craven and Vicar of Halifax, appointed the Rev. John Henry Warneford as the first incumbent when he was 27 years of age. There were no church buildings for some years. Warneford lived in rented accommodation and services were principally held in a licensed room at Greenroyd mansion which was also used as a schoolroom for the children of Skircoat Green. Other licensed worship rooms were at Salterhebble and at Copley.

Mr Warneford was a persistent man and with the aid of Archdeacon Musgrave land was obtained from the governors of the Waterhouse Charities, known as Middle Field, Dudwell. Part of this land was assigned for the building of the first All Saints' School, opened in 1854. Later this school and a second one at Chapel Lane, Salterhebble (built in the early 1870's) were closed on 31st May 1907 and a new school was built and opened on the 23rd August 1909.

Having built a school Warneford announced the intention of erecting a church. His proposal was laughed at but he wrote over 14,000 circular letters and gradually raised a fund. His persistence won and the church's foundation stone was laid on the 26th August 1857 and the building was consecrated by Robert Bickesteth, Bishop of Ripon on 21st October 1858. This was prior to the creation of Wakefield Diocese.

The church exclusive of fittings and rural decorations cost £2,500. Designed by Mallinson and Healey, of Halifax and Bradford, its architectural style is known as middle pointed Gothic. Consisting of a nave (with clerestory), aisles, transepts and chancel, with a north side porch and tower and broach spire (120 feet high) on the south transept the nave originally had four bays. In 1874 a further bay was added increasing the length by 14 feet.

The fittings and windows were gifts by several benefactors notable amongst them being W. I., Tom and George Holdsworth, The Rawson family and other notables.

The population of the area was growing rapidly and Warneford, later made a Canon of Wakefield, carried out a devoted ministry usually assisted by one curate but occasionally two curates.

The original graveyard of "1 acre, 1 rood and 22 perches" had three later additions the last being in 1937.

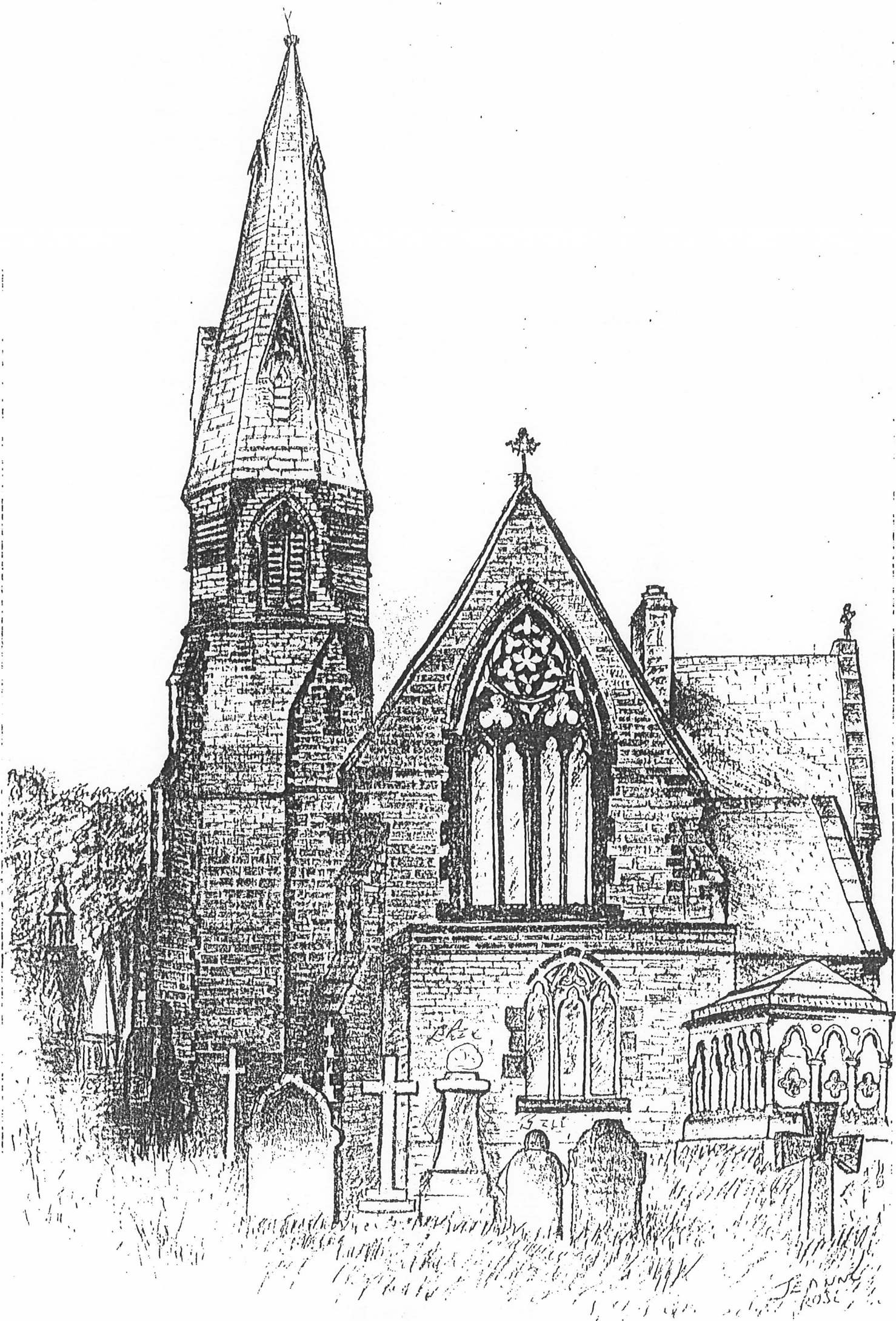
At various periods, Copley in 1865, St Judes' in 1890 and Siddal became separate parishes.

Canon Warneford's ministry lasted 52 years and one of his successors Thomas Rose Price was Vicar from 1907 to 1937.

The present Vicar, the Rev Stuart Forbes is only the eighth Vicar of the parish.

The church building has been well maintained and has had substantial improvements in the 1980's including a new heating system, improvements to the windows, carpetting, an organ restoration and some re-ordering to create circulation and fellowship space.

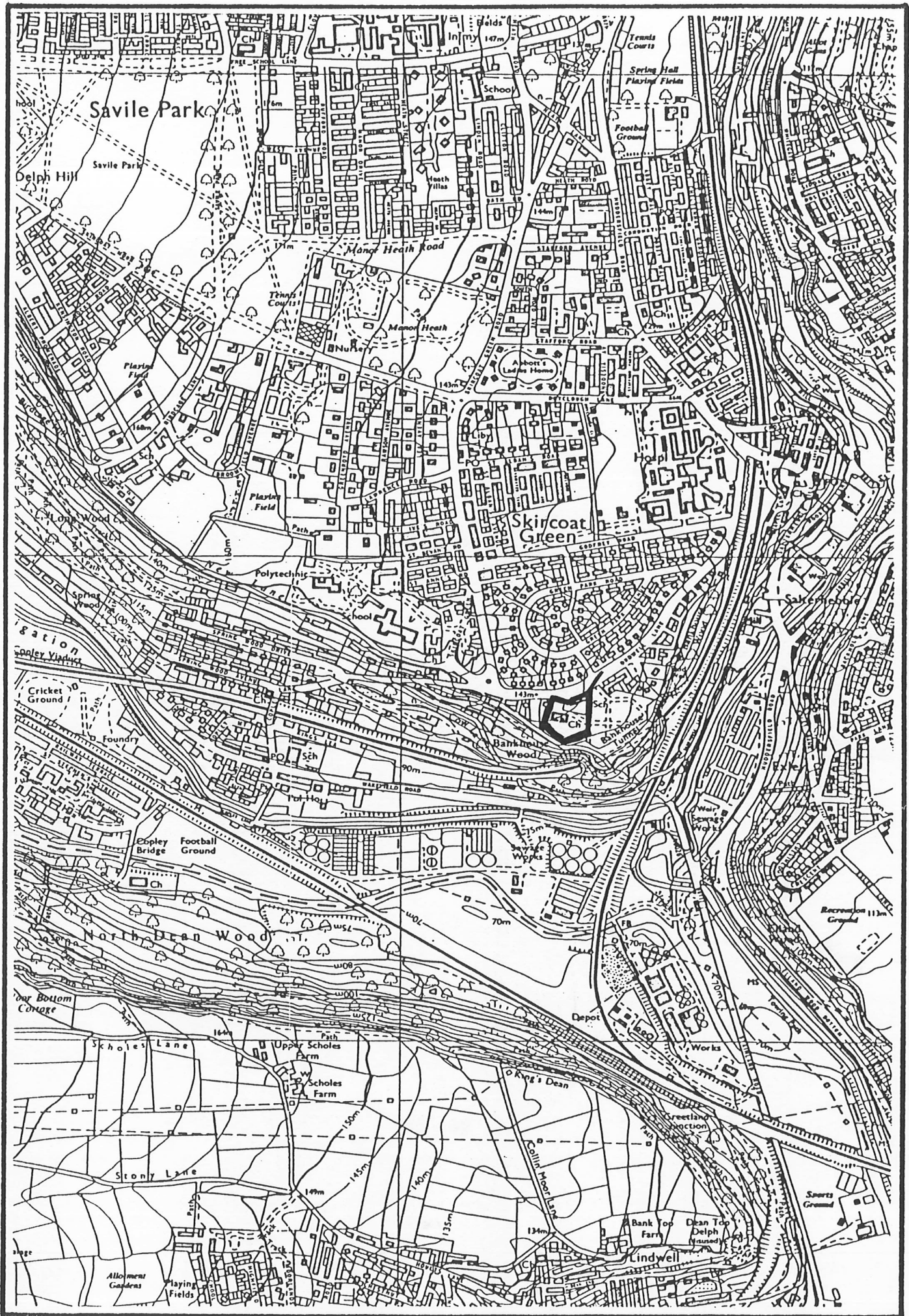

## TRANSCRIPTION NOTES FOR HALIFAX ALL SAINTS CHURCH

This book has been produced by Calderdale Monuments Inscriptions, which is a project set up by the National Association for the Care and Resettlement of Offenders, Community Programme Scheme, funded by Manpower Services Commission. Our aim is to locate, map, and record graveyards throughout Calderdale, with details of size, condition, grave numbers and most important of all, monumental inscriptions. These records will be indexed and produced in book form and a limited number of copies of the finished work will be deposited in the relevant Record Offices in Yorkshire and London.

The first graveyard to be recorded on the project was All Saints', Salterhebble. Work commenced in early May 1986 and finished in mid-October of the same year. During the first few weeks we encountered problems of safety in the graveyard and work there was halted for a few weeks. During the time we were away from All Saints' we recorded the inscriptions at Southowram Methodist Church, and these were the first records to be produced by us. We returned to All Saints in July when the problems had been rectified.

The graveyard covers an area of 4.5 acres, with a total number of approximately 3,800 grave plots. Before we actually started work there, certain areas had been designated for "grassing over", this involved the removal of kerbstones from around the graves in order to level out the ground and seed it. A team of stonemasons were well ahead of us in this work and many of the kerbstones had already been removed, causing headstones to fall over and ground to collapse. These areas were obviously the first to be tackled in an attempt to record as much information as possible before it disappeared for all time. Work on these areas proved difficult, as it was almost impossible to ascertain whether the headstones were in the correct positions according to the numbered graveyard plan that we were working from. This plan was drawn up in 1978 by a Mr Clayton, Chartered Surveyor, Dudwell Lane, Halifax. As no plan had been in existence before this, many of the numbers were deduced and the plan is not guaranteed to be accurate, but only to be used as a guide to people wishing to locate graves. Every effort was made to number the headstones correctly, pacing out grave plots from which stones had already been removed, but some slight deviation in numbering may occur from records in the burial registers. The graveyard has been divided into seven sections in order that the numbers follow on in order, and these sections are clearly marked on the graveyard plan included in this book. The sections are; West Wall Section, Section 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. At some time in the past a wall ran diagonally through the whole of Section 5, this wall was later demolished and the burial ground extended. The numbers on this section do not appear to follow any logical pattern and so we have marked on the plan where the wall was originally and split the numbers on this section into 2, in order that they follow on in sequence. The inscriptions from inside the church have also been recorded. Stones were later removed from Section 3, but these were recorded before they were taken away. Sections 4, 5 and 6 had not been designated for clearance work and so all of the monuments there are intact.

At the start of the project the work proved very difficult due to the amount of weeds and foliage and when we first arrived in May the whole graveyard was completely overgrown. The task of cutting down this growth in order to gain access to the stones to read them was enormous. Constant rain for the first few weeks also caused a problem, not only in stopping transcription work but also in aiding the weeds to grow to an almost unbelievable height. As the weather improved and the weeds were cut down, the team grew in numbers and work began in earnest.

After the information from All Saints' had been processed and formatted, two gravestones were unearthed. These are listed, together with any recent additions to inscriptions that we have noticed, in a separate miscellaneous section at the end of the book.

Due to the size of the graveyard it has been necessary to split our work into three volumes;

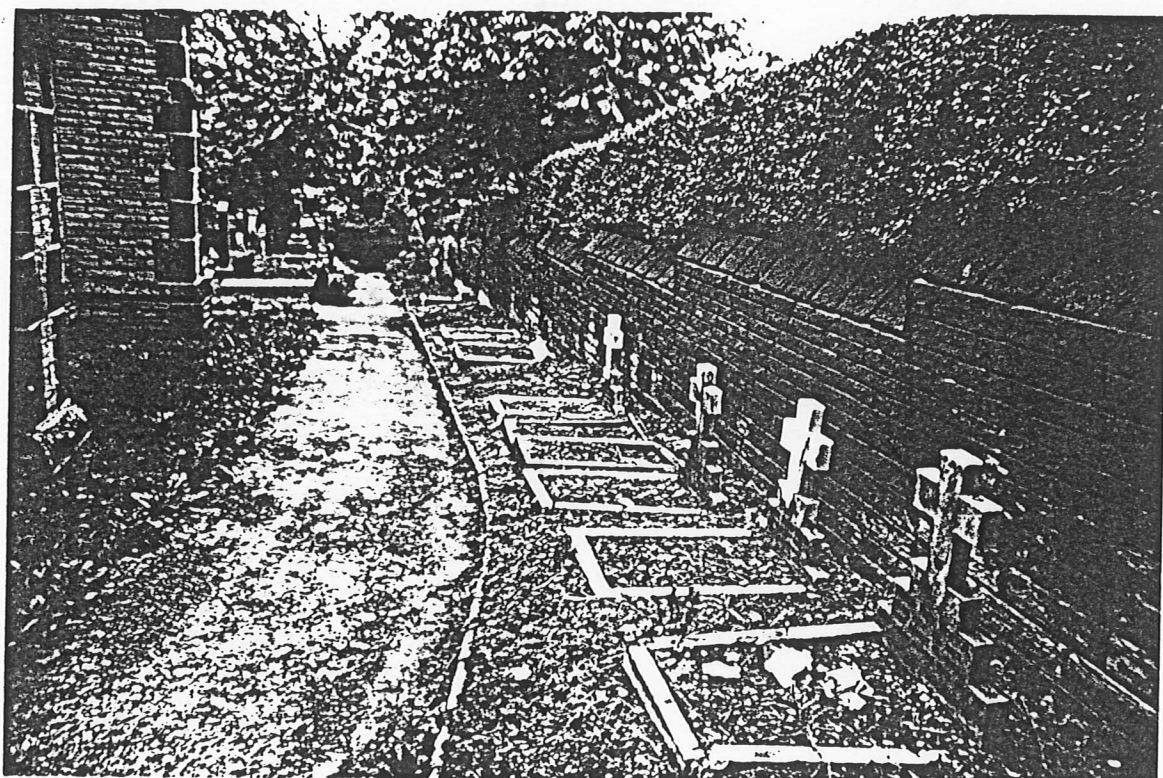

The inscriptions have been recorded verbatim, the end of a line being denoted by an oblique (/), where words have been impossible to decipher this is shown by placing square brackets thus [?], masons names have been noted where present, and these appear at the end of the inscription, if a word has been wrongly spelt it has been recorded so followed by {sic}. Sadly it is not possible to show, using a computer to produce this book, the beautiful and intricate workmanship on these monuments, but photographs of some of the most outstanding have been included.

The inscriptions from the two graves on the grass verge at the front of the church have been included with the inscriptions from inside the church and have been numbered OC1. and OC2.

At the beginning of Section 4, plots 1-9 are found followed by 1001-1540 . Plots 1-9 form a row of smaller graves situated in the middle of the block numbered 1001-1112. It is possible that these graves were a later addition, and they have been placed at the beginning of the section so as not to interrupt the continuity of numbering on the main section.

During the time that we were working at All Saints' we had numerous enquiries from the public concerning the location of family graves, and in most cases we were able to assist. We hope that this book will prove to be a valuable aid to many more people in tracing family connections.

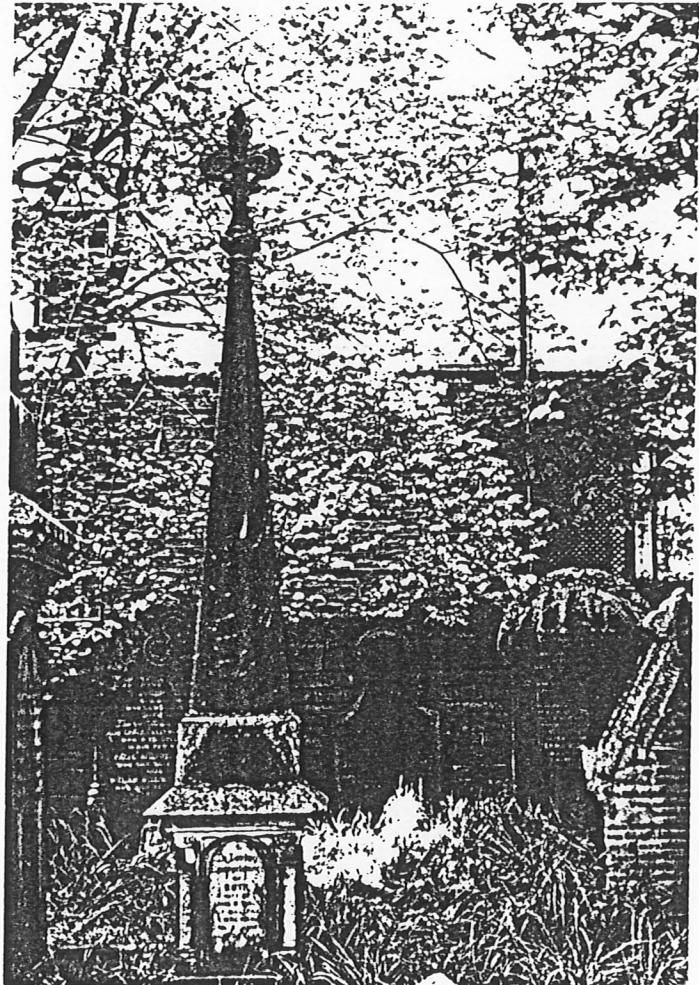
